

General Instruction to the candidates for examination

1. Check the e-Admit Card carefully and bring discrepancies, if any, to the notice of DSRVS immediately. Admit card is being sent to the candidate through email.
2. This examination is being conducted according to the method of remote proctored examination, during this examination time period, the online invigilator can cancel/paused the examination for looking around the candidate, seeking help from anyone, doing any other illegal activity.
3. The candidate is advised to go through this examination carefully, in case of any kind of fraud; If the exam is cancelled then the candidate himself will be responsible for that.
4. Bring this e-Admit card (print out), along with the (original) Photo Identity Card, whose number is mentioned in the e-Admit Card , in each session to secure admission to Examination Hall. E-Admit Card must be preserved till the declaration of the final results as its production before Service Selection Board is necessary.
5. You are responsible for safe custody of the e-Admit Card and in the event of any other person using this e-Admit Card, the onus lies on you to prove that you have not used the service of any impersonator.
6. Enter the examination hall as per the reporting time given in the admit card. Entrance to the examination hall closes 10 minutes before the scheduled time of commencement of examination in each session.
7. If you appear at a centre / sub-centre other than the one indicated by the dsrvs in your e-Admit Card, your answer scripts will not be evaluated and your candidature is liable to be cancelled.
8. Read the "Special Instructions for candidates admitted to the examination" given in "Rules for the Examination" available in Examination Notice and "Poster" containing instructions displayed outside the Examination Hall.
9. Your candidature to the examination is provisional.
10. Mobile Phones, Calculators, IT Gadgets and any other Communication device such as Bluetooth etc. are not allowed inside the premises where the examination is being conducted. Any Infringements of these instructions shall entail disciplinary action including ban from future examinations.
11. There will be penalty (Negative Marking) for wrong answers marked by a candidate in the objective type Question Papers.
12. Candidates are advised not to bring any valuables/costly items and bags to the Examination Halls, as safe keeping of the same cannot be assured. The dsrvs will not be responsible for any loss in this regard.
13. Candidates who do not have clear photographs on the e-admit card will have to bring a photo identity proof viz. Adhaar Card, Driving Licence, Passport, Voter ID Card etc. and two passport size photographs one for each session for appearing in the examination with an undertaking.
14. The questions will be bilingual i.e. Hindi and in English, wherever applicable, except for the test of language section of the paper.
15. Candidates are required to carry masks and sanitizers as per the COVID guidelines and must follow the COVID guidelines of the Government of India/Local Administration.
16. In this remote proctored exam, the complete screen record of the exam time duration will be with the institute, so candidates give the exam with patience.
